The Chamber of Commerce, in conjunction with the US Army Armor Center and School, held a Fort Knox Town Hall Information Fair at Fort Knox, Kentucky on April 29, 2010. More than 162 schools, churches, counties, businesses and groups from the Chattahoochee Valley participated in the information fair for Fort Knox soldiers, civilian workers and family members preparing to move to Fort Benning over the next 18 months as part of Base Realignment and Closure. ## Live Station of the Cross

Each station is dramatically reenacted as the actors quietly and reverently make the scenes come alive to the audience. The fifth graders produce 2 performances with one geared to the pre-K-4<sup>th</sup> grade students, and the second geared to 6<sup>th</sup>-12 grade students. Matt Oliver, who portrayed Jesus, commented, "I knew what Jesus felt like as he was going to die on the cross." Isabella Lopez, who portrayed Mary, said, "I enjoyed playing the part of Mary. It made me think about how it was for Jesus to do that and for his mother and friends to see him like that."



## Seals for Seals

In case you haven't already heard, the Extended Day program wants your plastic bottle tops. As part of their program, Seals for Seals, the students that go to Extended Day are encouraged to take the tops of their drink bottles and put them in a jar beside the trash cans. Students learned the importance of watching what you throw away because sometimes it can harm the environment. When bottle caps are thrown away, they will pop off the bottle and small animals like birds and seals will try to eat them and will end up choking on them. The city of Columbus is also asking that people start taking their bottle tops off so that their machines will not have to use a lot of energy to crush bottles with air trapped inside. If you take the bottle top off, you end up saving animals and tax dollars.
