Twelve Month Tuition Schedule for Payments Starting June 2012 and Ending May 2013

Tuition includes books; it does NOT include uniforms or school lunches.

Fees and Discounts

Application for Admission Fee	\$50 per student, non-refundable
Registration Fee	\$250 per student, non-refundable - \$500 family maximum
Sibling discount	\$300 for second sibling, \$500 for third sibling
Fourth Child Tuition Rate	\$500 per year
Lower School Activity Fee	\$150 per student, non-refundable (Pre-K – 8)
High School Activity & Lab Fee	\$175 per student, non-refundable (9 -12)
Extended Day Registration Fee	\$40 per family (Pre-K – 8)
Graduation Fee	\$75 (seniors only)
Discount for Full Payment	1% discount for payment in full (cash or check) by June 28 (no discount for credit card payments due to processing fees)

Parish Subsidy is available from Deanery Churches with tuition credits from \$350 to \$700 per student for participating families.

*Every effort is made to keep the cost of tuition and fees at a manageable level for families desiring a Catholic School education. At St. Anne-Pacelli the actual annual cost of educating a high school student is **\$9,850 and \$6,530 for a student in grades Pre-K-8**. For comparison purposes, the average cost for educating a traditional student across all grade levels in the Muscogee County School District is **\$8,702 per year**. As you can see, the tuition amount listed above does not cover the full and actual cost of education. The difference between the actual cost to educate and tuition collected is covered by generous support from St. Anne Catholic Church, other local Catholic Churches, the St. Anne-Pacelli Annual Fund, the Deimel Legacy Ball, and various other funding sources.*
